Our team of experts are here to offer free, confidential and impartial support to parents and carers of Stockport children and young people aged between 0 and 25 who have or may have Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.



We also provide independent advice and support directly to young people aged between 16 and 25 who have or may have Special Educational Needs and Disabilities. Young people can access the service in their own right or with the support of their parents.

What support do we provide?

- Advice on all levels of support including SEND support in school, Education, Health & Care Plans and transition to post 16, exclusions and transport etc
- Advice on gathering, understanding and interpreting information and applying it to your own situation.
- Individual casework where needed including support preparing for and in attending meetings
- Information on resolving disagreements, complaints procedures and means of redress including support to manage mediation and appeals to the SEND tribunal

We are an established local charity in Stockport and work with people with disabilities to understand and achieve their aspirations for a happy and fulfilled future.
