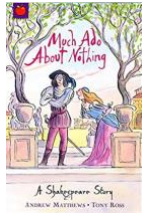


## English



Next half term our focus will be on the book *Much Ado About Nothing* – A Shakespeare story or *Much Ado About Nothing* – Shakespeare No Fear.

The focus on this unit will be the historical context and significance of Shakespeare, Language of description and double meaning, features of plays and understanding and applying themes.

## RE

This half term we will be looking at the Hindu Community.

We will cover:

- The concept of sannyasa (renunciation)
- What is lifelike in modern Britain as a Hindu?
- What is the Kumbh Mela?

## Science



We will be studying:

- Human Reproduction
- Fertilisation
- Changes that occur during menstrual cycle
- Flowers and Pollination
- Fruits and seeds

We will study the basic needs of animals, for survival (water, food and air) and the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

## PHSE

We will be studying healthy lifestyles.

To do this we will cover what a balanced diet is, how to make independent healthy choices and how to manage influences on body image.

In addition, we will look at the importance of exercise and the benefits of physical exercise on our mental health, the importance of sleep and how this can impact on our day.

We will be looking at how the students can take an increased responsibility for their physical health.

## History

Next half term we will be focusing on the period of 1920-1950 USA, Britain and Germany.

We will be looking at major battles, Blitzkrieg, D-Day landings and war in the sea and air. The Holocaust, what it was and why it happened, conditions in camps and the final solution.

Finally, we will look at international relations, the League of Nations, and the United Nations.

## Art

This half term we will be looking at surrealism.

## Food Technology

This half term our topic is Food from different countries- China

We will discover what ingredients are used in Chinese cooking and what type of food is usually eaten in Chinese households and how Chinese food differ from European/British food.

We will also explore what food is eaten during different celebrations such as Chinese New Year

During our cookery sessions we will cook, taste and evaluate different types of Chinese dishes.

## Maths

Over this half term we will be continuing to teach a bespoke model of maths to students depending on the area of the National Curriculum they are when combined with the Inscape House Level.

Topics being covered are:

- Percentages
- Multiplication and Division
- Length and Perimeter
- Algebraic sequences
- Decimals.

These will be taught using a variety of concrete, pictorial and abstract methods.

## ICT

This half term we will be looking at Programs.

Students will know how to write executable programs in at least one language.
