Literacy, Language and Communication

This half term, we will be building on our work from last term. We will be looking at sentence structures and how to correctly punctuate them

We will also be focusing on our handwriting and ensuring we have the correct formation for our letters and that the writing is on the line with consistent spacing in between words.

For reading we will be focusing on our comprehension skills.

Creativity - Art

This term we will be making story books and pop-up pictures.

We will look into the process of making the image pop up as well as what sort of picture would be best suited for this process.

My World - Science

This half term we will be studying animal classification. This will be done a variety of ways such as practical activities in class and digitally on our electronic whiteboard.

We will be looking at a wide range of habitats for animals and how animals have adapted for that habitat.

Finally, we will be looking at the diet of a wide range of animals.

Understanding Me and My Relationships

This term we will be looking at recognising and accepting differences between people, understanding and accepting changes that happen during puberty and the importance of person space.

We will be doing this through a variety of methods such as roleplay, the use technology and written tasks.

My World - Humanities

During this half term our focus is recycling and looking after the planet.

We will be looking at a wide range of objects and what they could be recycled into as well as already recycled items and thinking about their first use.

We will also be looking at different ways of looking after the plant.

Creativity - Music

This is a student led activity where the focus will be on the interest of the student.

We have a variety of musical instruments, and the lessons will tailored to the students selection.

My World – Food Technology

We will be looking at how we can make healthy junk food. The students will be making a range of foods including pastas.

Maths

This half term we will be transitioning from a practical approach to maths to focus on our reasoning and problem-solving skills linking to recycled items.

We will still be using concrete items for the students to manipulate to help solve the problems.

The transition from fluency to a more problem-solving approach will ensure the students have a deeper understanding of the concepts.

Physical Development

We will be exploring Boccia. We will be working on our hand and eye coordination judging distances and becoming more familiar with working as a group.

This activity will help improve muscle control for our students.
