Foundation: working towards food hygiene, safety skills and healthy eating whilst making simple meals.

Outdoor adventure: walking tours at Lyme Park to explore different types of landscapes.

Community Access

Preparing to go shopping, using a shopping list and shopping basket, scanning items and paying for items.

My Creative Expression

Art: Woodland craft

Complete a personal care routine when going swimming (getting dressed/undressed and showering) and show appropriate interaction with a range of people.

Fieldwork: observing, understanding and exploring everyday natural settings.
