- Counting the tins 3 times a year (or as and when required) and delivering the donations to the Together Trust central office (Schools Hill, Cheadle, SK8 1JE)
- Thanking the local shops and businesses for their ongoing support
- Inspiring others to support the work of the Together Trust

- Able to communicate via email and have access to a computer
- Be comfortable counting large amounts of coins
