

## Qualifications gained by students at Inscape House School 2019

Students at Inscape House School have opportunities to work towards a range of qualifications that will best prepare them for their next steps in life. In our drive to ensure students achieve their potential, teachers map a qualifications pathway that is appropriate to their capabilities and to their future plans. It is essential for student's wellbeing and self esteem that qualifications are both a challenge and achievable to an individual. This way progress is made and achievement is secured. We balance this carefully with knowing each students anxieties when facing exam pressures and providing the right therapeutic support to help each student achieve the best outcomes possible. If students continue into Post 16, they will have opportunities to repeat their exams to achieve a higher grade. Pupils taking exams are in year 11, 12, 13 and 14

### Qualifications and awards on offer include:

- level 3 qualifications – AS computing and Art, A' level Art, photography and Gold Arts award
- GCSE English, Maths, Science, Art
- Bronze and silver Arts Award
- GCSE equivalent qualifications such as Cambridge Nationals in ICT
- Level 1 and Entry level qualifications in English, Maths, Science, Art, PE and Computing
- Level 1 and level 2 B-Tec in Food technology
- We have 'Academy 21', an online teaching school to expand GCSE qualifications available to students if they have a particular interest or are unable to access teaching in a group.
- Entry 3, Level 1 and 2 ASDAN qualifications in Personal Social Development and Enterprise & Employability skills
- ASDAN Towards Independence (supported learners)
- In the past, students have been able to access teaching in a local secondary school as part of our 'Kingsway Partnership'
- Entry 2, 3, Level 1 and level 2 Functional Skills
- External qualifications via Tannery, College, Noah's Art etc.

### Out of our five 2019 P16 'Independent learner' Y14 leavers:

- 1 student began an apprenticeship in Web development – Purple Mountain Media
- 1 student started at a mainstream college (Salford City College) to complete a Level 1 Car Maintenance course
- 1 Student started at a mainstream college (Salford City College) to complete a Level 1 Catering & Hospitality course

- 1 Student started at a mainstream college to complete a pre-internship course (Trafford College)
- 1 Student left without any provision in place as he wanted to find a job – The school endeavoured to support and ensured that positive steps were involved yet the learner rejected their support
- 1 Y 14 supported student started at a specialist college to complete a life skills course (The Seashell Trust)

8 students from the main school Y11 progressed to our Post 16 unit to continue their education here

1 student left Y11 to attend a mainstream college
