

Physical education and sport premium action plan

Our plan aims to improve the quality and breadth of PE, sport provision. We aim to increase participation in PE and Sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and fulfil their potential through fun and engaging activities.

Aims

- The provision will be challenging and appropriate and the support mechanisms in place to allow all to reach their full potential. The provision will be inclusive, engaging, innovative, inspiring and raise aspirations. It will provide high quality sustainable Physical Education and sport within the curriculum.
- All the key concepts to develop pupils' competence, performance, creativity and healthy lifestyles will be implemented. We aim to give as broad a base of learning as is possible so that all pupils can develop interest and understanding in many different areas.
- Each year we aim to raise the standard of all aspects of the PE provision within our school and strive to provide the best possible opportunities for our children to achieve the potential in a fun and safe environment.

Funding

Most schools with primary-age pupils receive the PE and sport premium. This includes maintained schools and academies, special schools and non-maintained special schools, and pupil referral units (PRUs). In 2018-2019, schools with 16 or fewer eligible pupils will receive £1,000 per pupil. Therefore the total allocation for Inscape House for 15 pupils is £15000.
