**3** For the first time, the Census will ask about your sexual orientation, your gender identity and your Armed Forces background. **Make sure you get counted.**



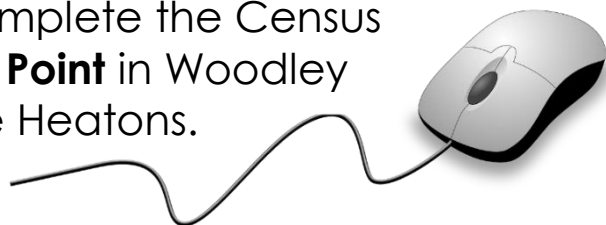
**4** You can request your own copy of the Census separate to the rest of your household by calling the number above, so you can write in the identities that most accurately represent **you**.



No one can identify you in the Census statistics that are published, and government services you access will **not** be able to see any personal information you provide.
