These are the exciting things I will be studying this half term...

English

This half term we will be studying the book "A Long Walk To Water". We will be covering a range of non-fiction writing styles and texts to support the novel study.



Science

This half term we will be looking at sound and waves.

We will be looking at the type of waves – transverse or longitudinal, we will be looking at how sound waves are measured, echoes, reflection and absorption of sound.

We will be doing practical tasks throughout the unit to ensure students have a clear understanding.

PHSE

This half-term we will be focusing on 'diversity.' We will explore what identity is as well as learning to recognise that we live in a diverse society where we all have rights and responsibilities. We will then move on to explore the concepts of 'stereotypes,' 'prejudice,' and 'discrimination,' as well as a focus on bullying.

e Humanities

Geography: Physical landscapes and processes that shape our coasts. Looking at waves and their impact, life at the coast and how we protect the coast.

History: Life in the Middle Ages. Villages before 1066, daily life, changes in towns, life in London and the role of women.

Art

We will be focusing on the theme of colour theory, encompassing colour mixing; pattern creation; tints and shades; primary, secondary and tertiary colours; hot and cold colours; symbolism in patterning and use of fluorescents.

Outdoor Education

This half-term our subject focus in Outdoor Education will be Science. The topic focus specifically will be in 'uses of everyday materials.' We will be exploring the suitability of everyday materials for different purposes. We will also be exploring how different materials can be manipulated.

Maths

This half-term we will initially continue with our work on multiplication and division at the appropriate level for each student, this could include column multiplication, dividing numbers by 2, 5 and 10 and making equal groups. We will then move on to Statistics, including the use of tally charts, pictograms, bar charts and line graphs.

ICT

This half term students will complete the module: App Development in AppShed. Students will learn about the different types of apps available and how they work, will design and create their own simple app using AppShed (an online rapid application App Development facility), and will have the option to download and publish their app on the App Store if they wish.

RE

This half term we will be looking at God and Buddhism We will be asking Who is a Buddhist and what do they believe? What are the key principles, beliefs and practices of Buddhism? Who is Siddhartha Gautama and what is a Buddha?

We will be doing a range of interactive lessons to develop and engage of learner.
