

Communication

This half term we are looking at stories from Ancient Greece, with a focus on heroes and villains.

We will be looking at the different tasks of Hercules and writing narratives on these using colourful semantics.

My World – Science

In science we will be identify plants, animals and fungi around us, and how they can be useful or dangerous.

My World – Humanities

This half term in Heroes and Villains we will explore:

Ancient Greece from Heroes and villains in Greek Mythology to Ancient and modern-day Greece; Geographical features; Using maps to locate Greece and experience what Greece is like now and what it was like long ago.

Reasoning

We will be looking at numbers and shape.

We will build on our knowledge of 2d shapes by identifying 3d shapes.

Creativity – Art

Students will be creating masks influenced by the works of A J Fossik and Claude Cahun to explore themes of identity, personality, disguises and cultural heritage.

Understanding Me and My Relationships

We are looking at safety in public scenarios.

Creativity – Music

Pupils will listen and respond to themes that represent heroes and villains of stage and screen. They will use this as inspiration to create their own sounds and motifs in that style and perform/share these individually and as a group.

Physical Development

We are continuing with trampolining in PE.

My World – Food Technology

This half term we will be exploring foods in movies with Heroes and Villains. We will recreate a selection of food like Spaghetti and Meatballs, doughnuts and chocolate chip cookies. Focussing on mixing, pouring and cutting skills.
