## Creativity - Art

We will be combining the class theme of 'postcards from the beach' and pattern to create motifs that can be used to make repeated pattern. Inspiration will be taken from images from nature, wildlife, buildings and postcards.

Artists being looked at include William Morris, Voysey, Celia Birtwell, Sarah Morris and 'The great wave off Kanagana' by Katsushika Hokusai

My World - Science

M In science we will be looking at Earth in space and other planets. We intend to create a physical representation of the solar system so students can gain a better insight into its make-up and scale.

Understanding Me and My Relationships

We are looking at the life journey of humans from baby to an adult. We will be looking at some of the physical changes that take place during this period.

My World - Humanities

This half term we will be investigating and exploring all things beach related. From what we see at the coast and why it is shaped that way to what we do at the seaside.


Pupils will listen to and learn to play songs and sounds of the summer. They will create sound effects to represent sounds heard at the beach and use virtual and real instruments to learn some summer Pop classics!

My World - Food Technology
This half term we will be looking at foods you eat at the beach. We will be creating different recipes including fish and chips, pasties and hot dogs focusing on different skills such as cutting and rolling.
