

Quick Guide to Choosing a School with an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP)

A parent or young person will be able to request a particular school or college when they receive a draft EHCP or an Amendment Notice amending an EHCP. This might be when they are getting an EHCP for the first time; if the EHCP is being amended after an annual review; or if the EHCP is being amended at any other time. The parent or young person has the right to request any of the following types of school or college

- A maintained school/nursery mainstream or special
- An academy mainstream or special
- An institution in the Further Education sector
- A non-maintained special school
- A Section 41 school

These are listed in Section 38(3) of the Children and Families Act 2014

The only reason the Local Authority can refuse the request is if;

- The setting is unsuitable for the age, ability, aptitude or SEN of the child or young person; or
- The attendance of the child or young person would be incompatible with the provision of efficient education for others, or efficient use of resources.
