

What type of information is on an EHCP?

Information about you



How you would like to communicate



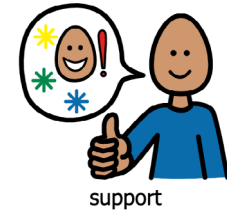
What you would like to do in the future



What things you might need help with



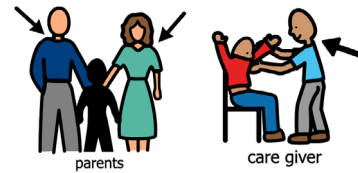
How you would like to be supported



Where you might like to go to school



People who help you can see your EHCP and work together to support you



You have the right to say what goes in your EHCP



EHCP's can be given to children and young people aged from 0-25 years old



EHCP's can stop if you go to university or get a job or if the local authority thinks you do not need it anymore



You can tell the local authority what you think about the plan and they have to listen to you



The local authority are sometimes called the council, they might say you do not need an EHCP anymore



If you do not agree then you can say so and you can ask your local information, advice and support service to help you
